






























District 2482, Bulgaria Boosts Rotary Public Image Nationwide

Karlovo Rotary Club of District 2482 launched a national prize in the name of "Evlogi and Hristo Georgiev", to be awarded annually in three categories: education (for promotion of education), philantropy (donations to worthy causes), business (successful development of Bulgarian business abroad). Nominations can be made by physical persons, NGOs, etc. to the Selection Committee. Winners receive a statuette of the brothers Evlogi and Hristo Georgiev plus a cash award at a special ceremony in May at the Ceremonial Hall of the Sofia University in the presence of public and dignitaries. The statuette is a small version of the monument in the town of Karlovo

RC Karlovo leads an annual fundraising campaign to support the initiative. In 2016 RC Gabrovo also pubished second eddition of the book "Evlogi and Hristo Georgiev: Life and Work" with the Rotary logo on the cover. The initiative has been widely covered by all media (TV, radio, nespapers, electronic editions) on local, regional and national level.

<u>History</u>

Brothers Evlogi and Hristo Georgiev, born in the town of Karlovo, Bulgaria, were prominent Bulgarian enterpreneurs and bankers in late 19th century. They were great visionaries and philantropists. They promoted education as a way forward for the country. During their lifetime they made numerous donations to young students, as well as considerable donations to schools, hospitals and chrches in Bulgaria, Bucharest, Thessalonica, Constantinople.

But their most significant philantropic act was the donation of 6 million gold Lev (the equivlent of 18 tons of gold) and a large plot in central Sofia for the purpose of a building for the Sofia University. This is one of the biggest donations in modern history. In recognition their statues are on both sides of the Sofia University main

Ankara Bahcelievler Rotary Club, the first club in Turkey to initiate the PolioPlus Project in 1985 are continuing their efforts to help eradicate polio virus on earth with a creative project. The club have attended 2. Modern Art Fair, ARTAnkara on March 9-13th with a booth in order to raise fund for the world's biggest NGO project. Rotarians have asked the painters and also the collectors to support the End Polio Project by donating their art work. More than 70 painters and artists have happily participated in the project and donated their paintings.

All the paintings were exhibited by RC Gallery & Auction House, Ankara. On 1st of May, there was the auction with many invited people not only Rotarians from D2430 but also collectors and those who would like to support the project. D2430 Ankara Bahcelievler Rotary Club President Emre Ozturk have addresed the artlovers and emphasized how much progress Rotary have made since the project has started. He also noted that the world is very close to getting rid of a human disease despite the difficult conditions at Afghanistan and Pakistan, the only two countries that have never stopped transmission of the wild Poliovirus. District 2430 Governor Canan Ersoz has mentioned the importance of the project and thanked all the painters and collectors who have contributed to the project. All 74 pieces have been sold at the auction. The fund will be used to vaccinate thousands of children to help eradicate Polio.

In 1985, Rotary launched its PolioPlus program, the first initiative to tackle global polio eradication through the mass vaccination of children. Rotary have contributed more than \$1.5 billion and countless volunteer hours to immunize more than 2.5 billion children in 122 countries. Ankara Bahçelievler Rotary Club members have been working, raising fund and supporting Rotary Foundation for the last three decades of this journey at which the world is very close in ending Polio.

Rotary Members Attended Jubilee Audience at the Vatican

Nearly 9,000 members of Rotary from across the globe attended the Jubilee Audience at the Vatican in St. Peter's Square on 30 April 2016 at the invitation of Pope Francis. At the end of the Audience, a delegation of Rotary members - led by Rotary International President K.R. Ravindran - met Pope Francis where he emphasized the importance of vaccinations against polio and urged Rotary to continue. Pope Francis follows Paul VI and John Paul II in connecting with Rotary to encourage their support of a more peaceful and compassionate world. "It is a tremendous honor to be part of this Jubilee Audience," said Ravindran. "Pope Francis has inspired men and women throughout the world - regardless of their faith - with his humble acts of kindness. His call to alleviate the root causes of extreme poverty and human suffering transcends religion, age, nationalism and politics. Rotary members from every religion, nation and creed share Pope Francis' spirit of mercy and compassion, which inspires us to act boldly to address the most difficult challenges facing our world today." By promoting peace, fighting disease, ending polio, providing clean water, sanitation and hygiene, supporting education, saving mothers and children and growing local economies, Rotary members are improving lives and bringing positive, lasting change to communities around the world. Rotary and its partners in the Global Polio Eradication Initiative are on the brink of making global health history as polio is slated to become the second human disease ever to be eliminated. Cases of this paralyzing but vaccine preventable disease have plummeted by more than 99.9 percent, from about 350,000 cases a year in 1988, to 74 confirmed in 2015. Since launching its PolioPlus program in 1985, Rotary has donated US\$1.5 billion and countless volunteer hours to protect 2.5 billion children in 122 countries from polio. More than 13 million people are able to walk today, who would otherwise have been paralyzed from polio. Pope Francis personally vaccinated a child against polio in Mexico this past February. While he was Archbishop Jorge Mario Bergoglio of Buenos Aires, Pope Francis was named an honorary member of Rotary - making him the first known pope to receive and accept a Rotary club membership.

At the end of the ceremony the young people received the keys of the apartments and the wishes from all for their new life and new challenges they will face.





On Saturday 6th of February 2016, District 2470 of Rotary International organized an informative Workshop on: "The problem of the refugees. Effect on Greece. Actions – Solutions. The contribution of the Social Organizations." At the Auditorium of "Radio Athens 9.84" at Technopolis (Gazi) of the Municipality of Athens. The Workshop was supported by RC Attica-West and Athens-Filothei. The official speaker of the Workshop Minister of Internal Affairs Panagiotis Kouroumplis described the actions scheduled by the Greek government to manage the problem. He referred to his recent meeting with the respective French and German Ministers and stretched the necessity to provide immediately more funds to Greece, which can't deal with the problem on its own. He criticized the other EU partners for their delay to realize the extent and the consequences of the current situation. He promised that the hotspots will be ready on time, by the 20th of February 2016. The Governor of D 2470 Gregory Grigoropoulos described shortly the coordinated activities of the district in co-operation with Rotary Clubs and Rotarians abroad, to support the refugees and emigrants disembarking in hundreds at the Greek Aegean islands, with tents, sleeping-bags, personal winter equipment, etc. Such provisions have already been delivered at Lesvos Island, which is heavily crowded with refugees. Two more hotspots in Dodecanese will be supported in the near future. Project title was carefully chosen being this year's club signature project; reflecting the real aim of our service which is "in love of Egypt" – ben7eb Masr- to convey the Public Image of Rotarians being only ordinary Egyptians who chose to rank service above self.

Project idea is roaming across all Alexandrian districts namely: Elgomrok- Sharq- Gharb- Wassat- Montaza 1&2 - Amreya- Agamy- Borg Al-Arab) targeting the most deprived areas within each district and serving literally on the streets to show the world true Rotarians in action. In other words, by the end of the year, project scope will inclusively have authentically encountered in service all geographic and demographic Alexandrian population. Project activities include:

- Medical convoy clinics in all medical fields.
- Pharmacy offering prescriptions for free.

- Field labs providing different medical lab analysis (blood, urine, stool and pregnancy test)
- Family planning clinic offering free contraception (pills and loops).
- Virus C initial screening.
- Medical screening (blood pressure; diabetes and obesity)
- Blood donation campaign.
- Charity Bazaar offering new and old clothes for as low as 5 L.E per piece for needy families Tree Planting.
- Literacy class inauguration by registration.
- Health awareness lectures for patients at waiting areas (malnutrition- lactation management (breast feeding)personal hygiene- Virus C infection control.
- Environmental lectures held by Bibliotheca Alexandrina on sorting garbage from home and recycling issues as well as solar energy.
- Peace related issues were tackled in an interactive session on conflict resolution and accepting the other.
- Water rationalization lectures for children to learn value for water as source of life, provided by Alexandria Drinking Water Company, who also provided parade with a truck with hugewater tap attracting attention of traffic. Significantly, the same station also provided a front desk to handle public questions & answers and receiving complaints.
- Children were cared for in a cheerful corner, where their faces were painted with Egyptian flag ; a coloring & handcrafting zone was also a pleasure to visit place . Kindergarten specialists were in charge of service.
- Starting second run, a new booth will be added providing a "micro-financing" opportunities for potential candidates in collaboration with other specialized NGOs
- Also, starting next run a new booth will be dedicated for vocational training opportunities for serious prospects in collaboration with relevant NGOs (marketing the opportunity and registration - a protocol is being worked on.
- Among Rotary's policy of branding , Only Rotary brand was used and the six areas of focus icons were clearly shown in project banners. In addition; on all site banners; matching icon was the main indication of service provided (i.e the health icon next to the banner of clinics...etc)

Attracting public attention to our cause, Golden Riders - a group of elite professionals sharing the hobby of motorcycling- who held a dedicated Friday morning ride across the city with elegant flags showing their support to RC Alexandria East . Starting from the Montaza Royal palace. Final destination and closing ceremony was Abo Al Abbass Square (service venue) where group photos were taken with large number of people with project banner. 

Samsun Ilkadim Rotary Club performed a humanitarian project for creating awareness to type II diabetes in Samsun city in Turkey on July the 2nd, in collaboration with the Samsun city Directorate of Turkish Ministry of Health, Samsun city Municipality, Canik town Municipality in Samsun and Cokay private hemodialysis center in Samsun. Sixteen volunteer nurses from a Ministry of Health hospital in Samsun (Gazi state hospital) and from Cokay private hemodialysis center, and all members of Samsun Ilkadim Rotary Club with their spouses and children participated in the project actively. Type II diabetes is accepted to be a sly metabolism disease which impairs most of the tissues and organs quickly and furtively. It is of importance to diagnose the disease via measuring the fasting and fullness blood-glucose levels. In the project, 284 individuals from a population that gathered to have "iftar (the dinner to stop the fasting)" in the municipality tent-meal service were analysed for their blood-glucose levels before and 2 hours following "iftar". Their data were recorded for the Turkish Ministry of Health archives and they were informed about diabetes. Brochures and documents of the Turkish Ministry of Health including information about healthy nourishment and diabetic life were distributed to all participants. Fiftyfour people, who were not aware of it, were determined to be a diabetic patient and they were guided to health centers for treatment. Glucose level recording cards which included the logos of Turkish Ministry of

Health and Samsun Ilkadim Rotary Club were given to all analysed individuals. the end of the project, all enrolled people received miscellaneous gifts from Samsun Ilkadim Rotary Club, Samsun city Municipality and Canik town Municipality. The overall project lasted in a very nice, happy and directive situation, and a lot of people interested in this important Rotarian performance.
