The Global Grant "Sanitation project for Gennimatas General Hospital, Thessaloniki, Greece" was successfully completed! The goal of the \$40478 project was the construction of five new and the reconstruction of five existing toilets at the B' University Orthopedic Clinic, as well as the construction of a metal access ramp at the entrance of the building. Additionally, leaflets with handwashing instructions in three languages (Greek, English and Arabic) were published and displayed. Finally, courses were established for the healthcare personnel and patients on personal hygiene, handwashing and the prevention measures to avoid the spread of hospital infections.

RC Thessaloniki East donated, using the contingency expenses of the Grant and after consulting with TRF, to the University General Hospital of Thessaloniki AHEPA, (assigned by the Hellenic Ministry of Health as the main treatment hospital for COVID-19 cases), five area sterilizing ultraviolet apparatuses worth \$3250..



#### Turkish Districts Fight Covid-19 with the Support of TRF


Rotary clubs from across the world have found themselves at the heart of their communities during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Never has President Mark Maloney's slogan of 'Rotary Connects The World' rung truer than in recent months. Rotarians have been on the front line with their day-to-day jobs delivering vital services and saving lives. But Rotary clubs too have been playing a huge part, tirelessly working to support the vulnerable.

In Turkey, where all three districts have been fund-raising to supply medical equipment following talks with hospital administrators. Thanks to The Rotary Foundation's decision to allow districts to apply for a maximum \$25,000 disaster response grant, with the waiving of a 30% foreign financing requirement for global grants, the districts have found ways to source some of the more expensive equipment, such as ventilators and CT scanners.

District 2420 is working on a \$210,000 project to provide CT scanners, District 2430 has funding to supply one hospital with a ventilator, and looking to add more. District 2440 is hoping to fund 10 hospital ventilators.

They divide financial help on the following way: For the Institute of Public Health of Serbia, funds went for one vehicle for doctors team on the field in prehospital activities and the other part for information system for following the epidemiology situation and education of future epidemiologists. The second part was spent in the Red Cross organization of Montenegro for the improvement of volunteers activities. This was a very successful project in such a short time with almost all clubs in the district. This is the best way to help our country and tho show that we are people of action and how Rotary truly connects the world.


#### District 2452 Bahrain RC's Support the Community for Sustainin...

Nesrin Demircioğlu International Ski Camp for Visually Impaired, organized by Istinye Rotary Association since 2002, was held at Uludag Beceren Hotel this year between March 8-11. At the end of the camp, which was attended by 20 visually impaired young people between the ages of 18-30, who were determined in partnership with the Istanbul Visually Impaired Rehabilitation Center, were trained for four days. The participants were given

certificates with a ceremony. Our Ski Camp for Visually Impaired which we organized was given the name of our late president Nesrin Demircioğlu who parted during her presidency, was held this year with around 120 participants. Since 2002, we have introduced approximately 400 young people to skiing. Our vision as RK is to be known as a club which provides youngsters with experience for a wonderful world.

With this vision:

We produce many projects for young people. Our goal at our ski camp project, which holds a special place among our projects; To contribute to the development of our visually impaired youngsters, to boost their selfconfidence, to expand their freedom, to encourage them to get to pick up a sport they have not tried before.

However, to ensure that non-disabled individuals mingle with the disabled and aim to understand and explain the feelings of our disabled youth, remove the barriers in our minds, develop a social sensitivity and a sense of responsibility, and encourage disabled people to produce solutions

Our visually impaired youngsters had their first ski experiences with our seasoned ski instructors and us, they successfully completed the camp and got their certificates.

During the camp, different types of training was provided besides ski training. The camp started with a training on "Behavioral Patterns to Visually Impaired" given by Psychologist Taner Tula in order to raise awareness of the participants. Day 2, UR. 2420. Our District Governor Nezih Bayındır informed about Rotary. Ski Instructor Ömer Ziya Sözüer shared his global experience with the visually impaired. Day 3, the Akut Foundation provided earthquake training to our visually impaired youth. We listened to Ersal Akcay's conversation "The Meetings in Nature" and the adventurous story of Nasuh Mahruki.

Beceren Hotel has hosted us for 17 years and sponsored accommodation for visually impaired youth and HDI Sigorta, has sponsored 9 meetings until now, and UR, has been sponsoring transportation and equipment for our youth. We would like to thank the 2420th District Federation, the 2420th District Governor Nezih Bayındır and his beloved wife Belkis, the Akut Foundation and the Akut Sports Association, who were with us at this year's event.

As members of the largest civil society organization in the world, we experience the pride and excitement of fulfilling such a meaningful project.




## District 2484 Takes Action Against Covid-19


## How to Maintain Member Engagement During Covid-19 Pandemic

This guide has been prepared to assist Clubs in their efforts to maintain Membership engagement at this difficult operational time. The guide is not exhaustive and many ideas may be added as the ingenuity and adaptability of our Clubs find new and innovative ways to maintain our fellowship. Online meetings are the preferred method of maintaining Club connection during the current emergency, there are some useful links appended to this guide to assist those unfamiliar with this format, and give further information for those who are familiar. Your District Leadership Team is, as always, an exceptional resource, this guide is an addition to your District's guidance and assistance. Your District Governor and the leadership team, District Membership Chair. Foundation and Public Image Chairs are a considerable source for information and assistance as we adapt to this new, and hopefully short term, reality

Overview Replacing In Person Meetings with Virtual meetings is an important part of this guide, but it is not it's entirety. However the initial overview largely concentrates on this possibility. We do strongly advise having a strong and significant online presence in the absence of 'in person' meetings. Please ensure that you maintain regular communication with your members about your Club's plans, including 'Rotary' news, Club announcements and the latest guidance on health/safety advise. Weekly communications in addition to any virtual meeting is essential.

If you are having virtual meetings, ensure consistency of your messaging by involving all Club Officers in the arrangements for these meetings. Clear and consistent messaging gives confidence and encourages good attendance. As stated, we strongly recommend having Virtual Meetings when in person meetings are not advisable. If this is not possible, regular Rotary communications are an essential service to your members Given the community concerns about this virus, let us not forget our own Rotary family, sometimes the caregivers need care, and we should be mindful of the needs of vulnerable Rotarians in our own Club, District or Zone. We are currently in training mode and thankfully our Districts have mostly completed many components of training our PEs and District officers. However some training requirements remain outstanding, and many Districts are now working hard to create an online District Training Assembly program. Your Rotary Coordinator team will be glad to assist in this endeavor, just let me know of your requirements. While mentioning Training, I would like to highlight the exceptional resource offered on our Rotary International Website at the Learning Center. The catalogue of available courses is extensive, covering all aspects of Rotary positions, disciplines, projects and initiatives. You can learn by subject, job or even develop your life skills in an easy to connect format, that you regulate on your own timescale. Please click the link in the appendix for further information. Guidance for a successful Online Meeting Choose your time - consider whether you want the virtual meeting to be at the regular Club meeting time and day, or do you want to meet at another time - always consider maximizing the attendance. Next choose a suitable duration - probably best not to exceed 1 hour, or perhaps you should consider shorter duration. Decide what elements of your 'in person' meeting you want to include in your virtual meeting - maintain the vibrancy, not everything can transfer to virtual format successfully Do keep all of the strong fellowship activities, eg Member profiles, entertaining speakers, happy bucks - figure out creative ways to collect these. Maintain a manageable meeting - Mute if necessary and set up a system for recognizing someone who wants to speak. Confirm if your speaker, if you have one, needs to use PowerPoint you will have to pass the 'share screen' option to your speaker or make other arrangements If you are comfortable using video - using the 'share screen' option - there are many wonderful Rotary videos available on the RI website, or on Vimeo or YouTube. You must remember to share audio as well as screen so all participants can hear. If you have not used the online meeting format before, do practice before going live. Get accustomed to the control elements offered and ensure good picture and sound quality.



D 2470 The Bomar Project, the initiative of the 2470 D (Southern Greece) to vaccinate 1500 refugees children 1-5 years old with the 5-valent vaccine (polio included) in the areas of the Refugees Reception and Identification Centers in the islands of Kos, Leros, Samos and Chios (Aegean Sea), has begun. A commission of food engineers, dietitians, members of TÜRGÖK, Rotary members and their spouses, and those who are visually impaired helped select 100 recipes for the book using various criteria paying special attention that the recipes were healthy and included ingredients that are easily available and could be cooked by the visually impaired without difficulty. Each recipe was tried at least once by the commission.

After selecting the recipes, Chef Omur Akkor from Bursa tried to cook the recipes with his eyes closed, then professionally edited each one of them and made them ready for publishing. He used standard measurements and explained each recipe by its timing and scent instead of visual presentations.

The recipes were classified in different categories (soups, salads, olive-oil dishes, appetizers, red/white meatfish dishes, rice-pasta, breads-patties-pastry, and cakes-cookies-desert) and were reviewed again and Brailleprinted after further editing.

While Braille-printing the cookbooks, spouses of the District 2440 Rotarians voice-recorded the recipes, detailed food information, nutrition, and practical ways of cooking for the audio CD format of the book. The recordings were done in a studio at the library.

Six different cooking courses were held in Izmir and Bursa for visually impaired at the library so they could practice the recipes. Practical kitchen sets (such as vegetable and fruit peeler, egg white and yolk separator) were given as a gift to the participants of these courses in order to make their lives easier in the kitchen. These cookbooks were sent to the members of TÜRGÖK free of charge. The cost of the cookbooks was covered by sponsors.

In 2014 The book participated to Gourmand World Cookbook Competition which took place in Beijing and won the 1st prize at Fundraising Category.

The Story of Bead Ayse & Bead Ali

A fund raising project for End Polio Fund by Adana Guney Rotary Club

No child shoud die or crippled because of a preventable disease. Thanks to Rotary International's great efforts since 1985 Polio is very close to be eradicated. Polio cases have dropped by 99.9 percent, from 350,000 cases in 1988 in 125 countries to 33 cases of wild poliovirus in 2018 in just two countries: Afghanistan and Pakistan. However, WHO still considers Republic of Congo, Ethiopia, Iraq, Syria, Kenya, Somalia, South Sudan and Yemen as high risk countries.

Helen Keller once said: "I cannot do everything, but I can do something". Adana Guney Rotary Club (District 2430 – Turkey) is celebrating their 25th anniversary. In 2019-20 they started a project named "Bead Ayse & Bead Ali", aiming to raise a money to be donated to Rotary's End Polio fund. The bead people hand made by the club members and spouses are now travelling to many places in Turkey and to even other countries. Bead Ayse and Bead Ali are helping to promote Rotary International and Adana Guney RC also raising awareness regarding efforts of Rotarians to eradicate Polio.

The club president Berkan Karatas says: "We feel very happy while making these bead people. The pleasure of producing something together increases exponentially, considering the purpose of the project. Thanks to the efforts and collaboration of Turkish Ministry of Health and Rotary, Polio had been eradicated in Turkey since 1998. But in today's conditions, polio is only a plane trip away. One sick child on the other side of the world, puts our children and grand children under risk.

PDG Canan Ersoz who is the leader of "Bead Ayse & Bead Ali" project in Adana Guney RC, had donated all the income from her personal paper quilling exibition to End Polio Fund three years ago and was awarded with Regional Service Award for a Polio-Free World for 2018-2019. Regarding Boncuk Ayse & Boncuk Ali project she says:

"Glass, wood, metal or plastic beads are used in the production of Boncuk Ayse and Boncuk Ali and sometimes beads of old jewelry from antique markets. During the production and promotion of hand made bead people

members and spouses accumulate different stories and memories. Each bead doll sets out for a beautiful and accurate purpose, to write their own story".

Shekhar Mehta, of the Rotary Club of Calcutta-Mahanagar, West Bengal, India, is the selection of the Nominating Committee for President of Rotary International for 2021-22. He will be declared the presidentnominee on 1 October if no challenging candidates have been suggested. Mehta acknowledges that current membership trends are a challenge and says that membership development should be Rotary's highest priority. He believes that focusing on regional plans, successfully transitioning Rotaractors into Rotary clubs, and increasing diversity and female members could yield a 5 percent net growth in membership each year. "A major brainstorming is needed to find effective solutions suited to different areas of the world," says Mehta. He adds that regional ethos and culture have to be taken into account to find localized solutions, as "one size does not fit all." He believes Rotary can extend to new geographical areas and countries. As a strong proponent of Rotary's strategic plan, Mehta says he will encourage clubs to use action plans and reinforce the core values of Rotary Mehta says Rotary needs to become more contemporary and adaptable by focusing on partnerships with governments and corporations, expanding partnerships with organizations that specialize in Rotary's areas of focus, and investing in technology.Mehta, an accountant, is chair of the Skyline Group, a real estate development company he founded. He is also a director of Operation Eyesight Universal (India), a Canadabased organization. Mehta has been actively involved in disaster response and is a trustee of ShelterBox, UK. After the 2004 Indian Ocean tsunami, he helped build nearly 500 homes for families affected by the disaster.Mehta pioneered a program that has performed more than 1,500 life-changing heart surgeries in South Asia. He is also the architect of the TEACH Program, which promotes literacy throughout India and has reached thousands of schools. A Rotary member since 1984, Mehta has served Rotary as director, member or chair of several committees, zone coordinator, training leader, member of The Rotary Foundation Cadre of Technical Advisers, and district governor. He is also the chair of Rotary Foundation (India). Mehta has received Rotary's Service Above Self Award and The Rotary Foundation's Citation for Meritorious Service and Distinguished Service Awards. He and his wife, Rashi, are Major Donors and members of the Bequest Society.

ECONOMIC - SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT ANATOLIAN WOMEN ENTREPRENEUR COOPERATIVE MILK AND CHEESE PLANT

The Rotary Global Donation Project was established under the leadership of Ankara Bahçelievler Rotary Club in Polatlı City, Ankara, TURKEY. With this big project, 5,000 people will have business and income. The project will open in 2019 May. The official opening of the project will take place within 3 weeks and announcements will be made within 2 weeks.

The cost of all machinery and equipment of this facility (95.450 USD) was met by Rotary. However, the economic size of the facility together with all the contributors is 2 million TL. The facility has 400 m<sup>2</sup> (4.305 ft<sup>2</sup>) closed area.

With this important project, a significant number of families in Ankara Polatlı will learn to process dairy products and develop their household economy in their region.

This project designed as a cheese production plant project by Bahçelievler Rotary Club. But, the project is also Economic and Social Development a model for women, peasants and young people in Turkey.

Ankara Bahçelievler Rotary Club President Rtn. Murat DOĞRU and his wife Nursun told about the project.

"Thanks to the project, approximately 5,000 people, including villages, learn quality milk production including villages, women entrepreneurs realize cheese and dairy products, and they develop a model for local cheese production techniques. Moreover, hygiene problems due to milk will be eliminated by this project. Thanks to the project, an annual value of TL 5 million will be provided in our country."

Women who do not have a job and shill have been employed and trained to produce cheese with this facility. Women will produce cheese, milk culture in the region will become widespread and the cheese they sell will provide a significant income for their family economy.

Moreover, the lack of hygiene in the dairy processing in the region will also eliminated. The plant will save community hygiene. The milk production and development model in villages will have a multiplier economy effect.

This giant project realized under the leadership of Ankara Bahçelievler Rotary Club. Project realized with the support of many international regions and clubs. 

District 2451- Egypt Mega Project - The FLOATING HOSPITAL

Our District had a dream; a world with healthy Kids who can eat healthy, play safe and enjoy a better life in any living conditions .

We aimed at developing kids throughout health and awareness , and educate kids, mothers and care givers on the right basics of general health and proper nutrition.

Our project is A Floating hospital - that cruses across the Nile through the south of Egypt - in some the most poorest Governorates in Egypt - A boat equipped with different medical clinics that can provide screening and checkups and Médecine to the most needy people that has no access to other medical outlets . The historical launch event held in swan on Feb. 26th, 2019 in the authentic city of Aswan was honored with the presence of RIP Barry Rassin, H.E. Minister of Health and Population, H.E. Aswan Governor and a large crowd of top notch key official, social and business figures .

The period of launch was from March 1st to April 30th, 2019 .

The first Floating Hospital, in the MENA region powered by Rotary Egypt embarked towards a better future for our kids in the less fortunate Upper Egypt governorates including 8 Governortes - Aswan. Luxor, Qena, Sohag, Assiout, Menia, Beni Suef and Giza carrying on a crew of pioneers amounting a total of 800 doctors, consultants, nurses and more than 600 volunteers (among which Rotarians and Rotaractors) joined hands to provide primary and advanced medical services.

In parallel, awareness campaigns and vocational training took place on ground catering for spreading awareness and correct misperceptions related to the kids right mental, physical and psychosocial development. Our main focus was kids from one day to 12 years as well as mothers, nurses and care givers all benefiting of the 18 medical units including specialized clinics, laboratory, scan center and pharmacy besides two conferences rooms on board for training and awareness

We exceeded the target number of beneficiaries (amounted at 50,000 pax) to reach out a total of 66,000 kids diagnosed and treated besides more than 200 awareness sessions conducted in eight governorates covering right nutrition, general health care, early literacy and special needs and a total number of 2,450 nurses and doctors enrolled in the training programs.

Primary health care covers the specialization of Pediatric, Audiology, ENT, Dermatology, Nutrition, Special Needs, Pediatric Surgery, Productive Health, Diabetes & Endocrime, Cardiology, Pulmonary, Ophthalmology, Orthopedic, Scoliosis, Allergy and Immunity, Neurology besides an in house laboratory, scan centre and pharmacy who issued over the whole project more than 850,000 medicines. Advanced health care covers surgeries and compensations tools including eye glasses, hearing aids and artificial lemps scheduled to be delivered and conducted during the period of May-Dec. 2019.

The Rotary Egypt Mega Project was conducted under the auspices of the ministries of health and population, Tahia Misr Fund as well as 62 partners including NGOs, corporate, multinationals, medical entities and official bodies.

Rotary Foundation Trustee Örsçelik Balkan was a member of the Rotary Club of Istanbul-Karaköy, Turkey. Balkan, a Rotary member since 1973, was the executive senior board director of the EAE Elektrik Company, a manufacturer of electrical products in Turkey and Russia. He was a developer in the field of renewable energy. He also taught strategic planning, effective communication, and project planning for an MBA program at Istanbul Kültür University. "Örsçelik was a Rotarian's Rotarian," says Rotary Foundation Chair Ron D. Burton. "He knew and loved Rotary and exemplified Rotary principles in everything he did. He always put others before himself. His Rotary work worldwide is a true testament to his commitment." He served Rotary as a district trainer, district governor, and RI director. He also served on numerous committees, including as chair of several. In 1999, he led disaster relief services in Turkey after a devastating earthquake. 



RIPE Mark Daniel Maloney, a member of the Rotary Club of Decatur, Alabama, USA, unveiled the 2019-20 presidential theme, *Rotary Connects the World*, to incoming district governors at Rotary's annual training event, the International Assembly, in San Diego, California, USA, on Monday, 14 January 2019. Rotary International President-elect Mark Daniel Maloney explained his vision for building a stronger Rotary,

calling on leaders to expand connections to their communities and to embrace innovative membership models. RI President-elect Mark Daniel Maloney announces the 2019-20 presidential theme, *Rotary Connects the World*, to incoming district governors in San Diego, California, USA.

Maloney, a member of the Rotary Club of Decatur, Alabama, USA, unveiled the 2019-20 presidential theme, *Rotary Connects the World*, to incoming district governors at Rotary's annual training event, the International Assembly, in San Diego, California, USA, on Monday.

"The first emphasis is to grow Rotary — to grow our service, to grow the impact of our projects, but most importantly, to grow our membership so that we can achieve more," Maloney said.

Maloney believes that connection is at the heart of the Rotary experience.

"(Rotary) allows us to connect with each other, in deep and meaningful ways, across our differences," Maloney said. "It connects us to people we would never otherwise have met, who are more like us than we ever could have known. It connects us to our communities, to professional opportunities, and to the people who need our help."

Maloney also called on every Rotary and Rotaract club to identify segments of their community not represented in their club by creating a membership committee with diverse members.

"Through Rotary, we connect to the incredible diversity of humanity on a truly unique footing, forging deep and lasting ties in pursuit of a common goal," he added. "In this ever more divided world, Rotary connects us all." Maloney urged leaders to offer alternative meeting experiences and service opportunities to make it easier for busy professionals and people with many family obligations to serve in leadership roles.

"We need to foster a culture where Rotary does not compete with the family, but rather complements it," Maloney said. "That means taking real, practical steps to change the existing culture: being realistic in our expectations, considerate in our scheduling, and welcoming of children at Rotary events on every level." Maloney said many of the barriers that prevent people from serving as leaders in Rotary are based on expectations that are no longer relevant.

"It is time to adapt, to change our culture, and to convey the message that you can be a great district governor without visiting every club individually, and a great president without doing everything yourself."

During 2019-20, Rotary will host a series of presidential conferences around the world, focusing on Rotary's relationship with the **United Nations** and the UN's sustainable development goals that many Rotary service projects support. More information will be available in July.

In 2020, the United Nations will celebrate the 75th anniversary of its charter and its mission of promoting peace. Rotary was one of 42 organizations the United States invited to serve as consultants to its delegation at the 1945 San Francisco conference, which led to the UN's charter. For decades, Rotary has worked alongside the United Nations to address humanitarian issues around the world. Today, Rotary holds the highest consultative status that the UN offers to nongovernmental organizations.

"Rotary shares the United Nations' enduring commitment to a healthier, more peaceful, and more sustainable world," Maloney said. "And Rotary offers something no other organization can match: an existing infrastructure that allows people from all over the world to connect in a spirit of service and peace and take meaningful action toward that goal."
