346 Runners Participated to Croatia - End Polio Run 2018

End Polio Race took place under snowflakes as part of the 18th Split half marathon on February 25th, 2018. The second year in a row Split half marathon and Rotary club Kastela supported Rotary internationals world program fighting polio. 346 runners registered for the race donating a total of 10.920 KN to PolioPlus fund. In addition to raising funds for End Polio, our goal is to inform the public about the issue of Polio in the world and about the importance of eradicating it worldwide. The race started at 9:10 on a mark is given by Croatian long-distance swimmer, Dina Levacic, owner of the triple crown for swimming La Manche, Catalina, and Manhattan. The race started at Riva (main promenade in Split) leading runners along the harbor up to City Administration building and back in the length of 2.5 km, and participants from 14 countries ran two laps. Split hosted runners from Croatia, Slovenia, Serbia, Montenegro, Germany, USA, Slovakia, Austria, Hungary, Romania, Australia, UK, and Switzerland. Oldest runner was 72 years old and youngest was 7 years old. Each participant arriving at the finish line received a finishers medal. The award ceremony was introduced by Split Dalmatia county Mayor Mr. Blazenko Boban and fastest runners received their medals and awards. The project was prepared by Sandra Russo Zelenovic, PolioPlus Subcommittee Chair, District 1913. Croatia with support by PR Committee District 1913. RC Kastela and RC Split had the highest number of members participating in the race and supporting the cause. As long as there is one child affected by Polio in the world children of the world are not safe from Polio and this is the message we want to send in order to help to reach the final goal - the world without Polio.

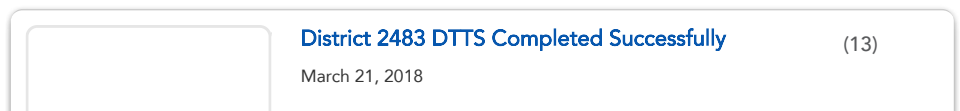

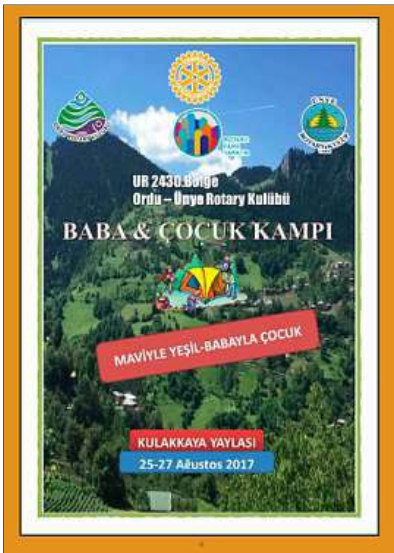

District 2451- Egypt , RC Cairo Al Orouba. Building Abu El Rish- Aswan Secondary School. The project started on the Rotary year 2015-2016, as a mega sustainable project serving one of the communities below poverty line. Abul Rish village in Aswan governorate was chosen as it is under poverty line and there was no Rotary in Aswan at that time It all started by holding Aswan Sunrise Conference attended by approx. 400 Rotarians and representatives of the government, business community and civil society .We aimed to introduce Rotary to Aswan and to understand the people's needs for development. Their need was a high school in Abu El Rish as the closest high school is 25KM away from the village with no decent transportation nor paved roads. The foundation stone was laid on 19th of February 2015 with the presence of the Past Rotary governor and the governor of Aswan. The club was a partial financial sponsor of the school . 2 Rotary clubs were organized in Aswan. Partnership was established between the Government , Business community& RC El Orouba to collaborate efforts . The school contains 12 mixed classrooms, up to 45 students each . It's been fully furnished for physics, chemistry, biology labs, a library, music and theatre. The board of trustees of the school included representatives from the community, the officials and Rotary Orouba members in order to oversee the progress of the school. Three years ago, based on extensive research and multiple visits to Giza Zoo, RC Giza Karnak identified this as a priority community development project. The zoo spreads over an area of 80 acres and welcomes 4 million visitors annually, however, we believe that with gradual positive changes within the Zoo, it could be revived as a favorite destination for both local and international visitors. Accordingly, our club signed a cooperation protocol with the Veterinary Service Authority of The Ministry of Agriculture and Land Reclaiming(RCC) to work on improving and developing the Zoo. So far, our accomplishments have been mainly increasing the number of benches up to 80, installing 60 garbage bins, buying an electric saw for trimming trees, renovating 2 washrooms and another 2 for special needs, bought a motor for water pumping, electric fans for animals welfare, 7 wheelchairs and the latest thing was planting around 3800 varieties of fruits, shading trees and flowers which is part of the District mega project this Rotarian year. 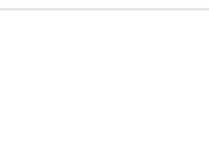

levels due to the huge influx of displaced Syrians and refugees into Lebanon, saying the impact of displacement has become excruciating. Aoun underlined the dire need for a solution in this regard, and reiterated that it has become urgent to find an efficient and appropriate solution. The audience was welcomed by the Chairman of the Conference Organizing Committee the past District Governor Jamil Mouawad who called for the "adoption of sustainable, comprehensive, and long-term practices in water management to achieve the development goal", and by District 2452 Governor Christina Covotsou-Patroclou, who stressed that "water is essential for peace because it is a source of life and without it we cannot survive".

The Rotary International President Ian Riseley highlighted the positive impact that water projects can have on school children. "A project that puts clean water and sanitation in a school, for example, is going to advance not only water and sanitation, but also basic education and literacy, disease preservation, and child death", he stressed.

In a speech he delivered, the Former Secretary General of the Arab League, H.E. Dr. Amr Moussa, said that water is one of the major problems that we face nowadays as it constitutes a scarce resource, thus calling for a "shared awareness in facing this problem".

Alfa chairman and CEO Marwan Hayek said that "the internet can be used to help avoid water pollution like using smart irrigation and smart farming technology". The opening ceremony hosted ministers, deputies, Rotarian Governors, Presidents of the Rotary clubs, presidents and members of the conference's organizing committees, in addition to a number of journalists and reporters. The conference aims at spreading awareness about water among governments and individuals, highlighting the significance of water as a highly important resource, and providing advice about water, health, hygiene and all their relevant issues. Questions such as climate change, global warming, and the impact of the economic development, the displacement and the geopolitical issues on water in the Middle East will be raised during the next two days. The conference will host a number of speakers, including the Minister of Information Melhem Riachi, the Minister of Telecommunications Jamal El Jarrah, the Minister of Health Ghassan Hasbani, among many other ministers and lawmakers. It will further include workshops about the importance of hygiene and health in the Lebanese Public Schools, so as to spread awareness among them and help them provide clean water for their students and guarantee the sustainability of their water filtration systems.

District 2430 PDG & Zone 20B ARC Canan Ersöz's organised a Paper Quilling Exhibition to support RI's End Polio Now Campaign. Brief information about the Artist, her work and purpose of the exhibition is as follows; WHO IS CANAN ERSÖZ ?

She is a medical doctor and professor of pathology. She is working at Acibadem Adana Hospital. I am a member of Adana Guney Rotary Club since 23 years.

WHAT IS QUILLING ?

Quilling is a very old art which uses paper as a main material. Thin paper strips are rolled, shaped and arranged. The history of this art dates back to the 13th and 14th centuries. It is known that French and Italian nuns at that time adorned the covers of religious books with quilling patterns. Due to the fragility of the material, the first works of this art have not survived unfortunately. However, few works from the 18th and 19th centuries are exhibited in famous museums such as Metropolitan and Boston Fine Arts Museums.

Her story with paper quilling started in 2005 with a book from an old friend and became her favorite hobby. Quilling's main material is paper. Every work made with quilling is unique, and can not be repeated even by the artist herself. Her greatest inspiration is nature and especially flowers. The completion time of one work varies from a few days to a few weeks

PURPOSE OF THE EXHIBITION

Her third exhibition, which took place between 19-25 January 2018, is aimed at contributing to the Rotary International's "End Polio Fund". Polio is a highly infectious, paralyzing, even deadly disease. The only protection is vaccination. Rotary International is one of the largest and most important non-governmental organizations in the world and its main interest is serving the community. Rotarians have been working extensively with the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, UNICEF, and the World Health Organization since 1985 to eradicate polio. In the 1980s, 350,000 people were paralyzed every year in the world because of polio, but today the disease is about to disappear. As of December 2017, the total number of new cases in the world is twenty and the disease is now only seen in Afghanistan, Pakistan and Nigeria. Rotary is particularly supportive of vaccination campaigns in those countries and countries where it is considered risky by WHO. Even one sick child on the other side of the world increases the risk of childhood epidemics anywhere in the world. That is why vaccination studies are of great importance. Rotary; has contributed billions of dollars to the End Polio campaigns and with the hard work of more than 20,000 volunteers in more than two hundred countries the disease will be vanished. There are 49 art work in this exhibition. This exhibition's income will be transferred to End Polio funds. I hope it will be beneficial to the children of the world.

International Assembly Completed in San Diego

Rotary International President-elect Barry Rassin laid out his vision for the future of the organization on Sunday, calling on leaders to work for a sustainable future and to inspire Rotarians and the community at large. Rassin, a member of the Rotary Club of East Nassau, New Providence, Bahamas, unveiled the 2018-19 presidential theme, Be the Inspiration, to incoming district governors at Rotary's International Assembly in San Diego, California, USA. "I want you to inspire in your clubs, your Rotarians, that desire for something greater. The drive to do more, to be more, to create something that will live beyond each of us." 2018-19 RI President Barry Rassin announces his presidential theme, Be the Inspiration, at Rotary's International Assembly. Rassin stressed the power of Rotary's new vision statement, "Together, we see a world where people unite and take action to create lasting change — across the globe, in our communities, and in ourselves." This describes the Rotary that leaders must help build, he said. To achieve this vision, the president-elect said, Rotarians must take care of the organization: "We are a membership organization first. And if we want to be able to serve, if we want to succeed in our goals — we have to take care of our members first." Rassin asked the incoming district governors to "inspire the club presidents, and the Rotarians in your districts, to want to change. To want to do more. To want to reach their own potential. It's your job to motivate them — and help them find their own way forward." Rassin noted that one source of inspiration has been Rotary's work to eradicate polio. He described the incredible progress made over the past three decades. In 1988, an estimated 350,000 people were paralyzed by the wild poliovirus; just 20 cases were reported in 2017 as of 27 December. "We are at an incredibly exciting time for polio eradication," he said, "a point at which each new case of polio could very well be the last." He emphasized that even when that last case of polio is recorded, the work won't be finished. "Polio won't be over, until the certifying commission says it's over—when not one poliovirus has been found, in a river, in a sewer, or in a paralyzed child, for at least three years," he said. "Until then, we have to keep doing everything we're doing now." He urged continued dedication to immunization and disease surveillance programs. Rotary has focused heavily on sustainability in its humanitarian work in recent years. Now, Rassin said, Rotarians must acknowledge some hard realities about pollution, environmental degradation, and climate change. He noted that 80 percent of his own country is within one meter of sea level. With sea levels projected to rise two meters by 2100, he said, "my country is going to be gone in 50 years, along with most of the islands in the Caribbean and coastal cities and low-lying areas all over the world." Rassin urged leaders to look at all of Rotary's service as part of a larger global system. He said that this means the incoming district governors must be an inspiration not only to clubs, but also to their communities. "We want the good we do to last. We want to make the world a better place. Not just here, not just for us, but everywhere, for everyone, for generations."

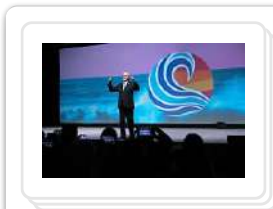

Update on District 2483's Centennial Foundation Project

Here are the necessary links for Project "100 for 100" – 100 projects for 100 schools in Serbia and Montenegro, which was started in our District to mark the hundred years of Rotary Foundation. The most important part of the project is the Global Grant undertaken by my Club with the aim to raise minimum 110,000 US Dollars and provide minimum 300 computers for IT classrooms in 30 schools in D2483 (see at site: www.100za100.com, facebook: www.facebook.com/100za100Rotary/, and this is video project presentation on link below https://youtu.be/2dgG3Yj_v2o).

On the occasion of Rotary Foundation Centennial District 2483 Serbia and Montenegro has initiated a project ~100 for 100~ - 100 projects for 100 schools in Serbia and Montenegro. Following the discussions we had with the Ministry of Education our main intention is to supply schools with computers, laptops and other necessary equipment for networking and thus contribute to implementation of Information and Communication Technology program in primary schools curriculum. The estimated number of computers still required is around 5,000.

The project has been planned to develop in several stages:

Stage 1

We have invited all Rotary clubs in District 2483 Serbia and Montenegro to start fundraising events and find sponsors in their local communities in order to provide computers for at least one school in their town . We have also asked them to invite their twin clubs from other districts to join in and offer their support to this project either by donating funds or by donating used computers. Deadline: October 30, 2017 and to be continued throughout 2017/2018 Rotarian year.

Stage 2

We are looking for sponsors who wish to support our project either by directing the funds to our Global Grant or by purchasing the equipment themselves. Sponsors can also donate used computers (not older than 5 years with Windows7 installed, which will be test approved by an authorized service) and used CISCO networking equipment as well. Deadline: October 30, 2017 and to be continued throughout 2017/2018 Rotarian year.

Stage 3

My club RC Beograd-Cukarica has brought a decision to apply for **Global Grant** in the value of minimum \$ 110,000 and is inviting friendly clubs and districts, asking for support in this project. We would be very happy if we could receive all the decisions until November 18, 2017 (10th anniversary of RC Beograd-Cukarica).

I would like to ask you to invite the clubs in your District to support us and make a donation for this Global Grant project or help us find sponsors in your District who could donate used computers not older than 5 years with Windows7 installed and/or CISCO networking equipment with transport to Belgrade.

I would appreciate very much if you and your District could bring a decision to donate a certain amount from your DD Fund which would enable us to receive a 100% contribution from TRF.

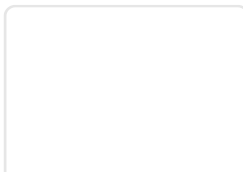

The Rotary Foundation has approved the project proposal "Rotary: No Stroke Bulgaria" as a global grant GG1756342.

The project addresses a serious humanitarian problem in Bulgaria – the stroke prevention through screening and early diagnosis of ischemic stroke. Bulgaria is the EC country with the highest death rate from this serious life-threatening medical condition, let alone the number of people with different levels of permanent disabilities, resulting from a stroke.

The total budget of the project is 98858.00 USD, formed with contributions from D2100-Italy (major contributor), RC Istanbul-Yenikoy (in cash), D4590 and D4310- Brasil and D2482-Bulgaria.

Four hospitals in four different cities in Bulgaria will receive up-to-date equipment for conducting a highly-efficient stroke-prevention screening program – the National Cardiological Hospital in Sofia, the University hospital in Bourgas, the University hospital in Rousse and University hospital "Eurohospital" in Plovdiv.

A total of six clubs from D2482 will join efforts in the development of the project. Those are RC Sofia-Vazrajdane, RC Plovdiv – Filipopol, RC Russe, RC Ruse-Dunav, RC Bourgas, RC Bourgas-Pyrgos, RC Bourgas-Primorie. Valuable support during the project development will come from D2100 (Italy) and RC Naples.

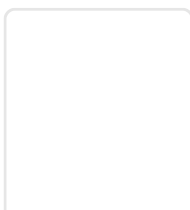

1. The green house for the project for the Rotary Year 2016-17 was lent by Rtn. Othman Janahi member of RC Manama in his farm. He always had a green house and was kind enough to help us plant the seeds and harvest the crop. Rtn. Othman Janahi's purpose in building the green house is to promote farming as viable business in Bahrain.
 2. Around 10 members were actively involved in the project. We have around 65 members in our club.
 3. Crops planted were tomatoes, cucumber, cabbage, marrows, pumpkin, carrots and bell pepper.
 4. The Green house project started with seeding the crops in 25 September 2016 and ended on 7 January with harvesting of the crops. Physically unable children from Society for the Blind, Al Rahman Centre and the Bahrain Down Syndrome Society were involved during the entire tenure of the project. We assisted them in sowing the crops in September 2016. And they were invited back on 7 January 2017 to harvest the crops. This way they can see the entire process of farming from the beginning to end.
 5. The funding was used from the earnings from last year's fund raiser. We organize the yearly Raft Race which generates funds for the next year projects.
 6. The measurements for the green house are 10 - 6 meters.

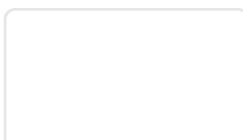

Rotary President-elect Sam F. Owori dies

Rotary International President-elect Sam F. Owori died unexpectedly on 13 July due to complications from surgery. Sam was a member of the Rotary Club Kampala, Uganda, for 38 years.

"Rotary has become a way of life for me – with the intrinsic value and core belief in mutual responsibility and concern for one another as a cornerstone," Sam said when he was nominated last year. "I feel immense satisfaction knowing that through Rotary, I've helped someone live better."

Sam's term as Rotary's 108th president would have begun on 1 July 2018.

"Please remember Sam as the outstanding, hard-working Rotarian he was," said Rotary International President Ian Riseley. "In this difficult time, I ask you to keep his wife, Norah, the Owori family and Sam's millions of friends around the world in your thoughts."

Under Sam's leadership, the number of clubs in Uganda swelled from nine to 89 over the course of 29 years. Sam saw in Rotary members "an incredible passion to make a difference," and wanted to "harness that enthusiasm and pride so that every project becomes the engine of peace and prosperity."

Sam was the chief executive officer of the Institute of Corporate Governance of Uganda, whose mission is to promote excellence in corporate governance principles and practice in the region by 2020. Previously, he was executive director of the African Development Bank and managing director of Uganda Commercial Bank Ltd., and director of Uganda Development Bank. He has also served as corporation secretary of the Central Bank of Uganda.

He served as member and chair of several boards including FAULU (U) Ltd., (now Opportunity Bank), the Uganda Heart Institute, the Centre for African Family Studies, Mulago Hospital Complex, Mukono Theological College, and the Kampala City Council.

Sam also was the currently vice-chair of the Hospice Africa Uganda, and member of the board and chair of the Audit Committee of PACE (Programme for Accessible Health, Communication and Education) in Uganda.

"Sam was a special person in so many ways, and his unexpected death is a huge loss to Rotary, his community and the world,"

From 24 to 29 July several memorial ceremonies took place. His body was buried on 29 July 2017. May his Soul Rest in Peace.

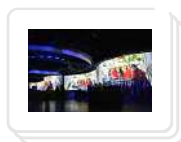

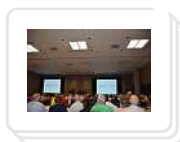

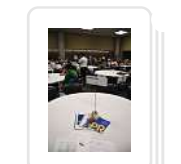
