Rotary/UNESCO-IHE Scholarships 2023/2024 for Water and Sanitation Professionals

The strategic partnership between the Rotary Foundation (TRF) and IHE Delft Institute for Water Education aims to tackle the world's water and sanitation crisis by increasing the number of trained professionals to devise, plan and implement solutions in developing and emerging countries. Through this partnership, a limited number of scholarships are awarded annually for graduate students at IHE Delft Institute for Water Education's campus in the Netherlands.

These scholarships are designed to promote long-term productive relationships between Rotarians and highly skilled water and sanitation professionals in their communities.

Since the inception of the partnership in 2012, some 150 scholarships have been awarded.

Rotarians interview and select from local candidates who have already been admitted the IHE Delft Institute for Water Education's regular MSc Programme in Water and Sustainable Development, in one of the following thematic tracks:

- Water and Health
- Water Resources and Ecosystems Health
- Water Hazards, Risks and Climate

When a Rotary scholarship has been awarded, the sponsoring Rotary Clubs maintains contact with the scholar throughout his or her studies. The financing of the successful candidates will be managed through Rotary's Global Grant process.

Presidential Message

As we planned for this Rotary year, I could have never "imagined" the breadth of stories we would encounter nor the scope of the people we would meet.

I find oxygen in sharing time with our members — hearing their truths and learning about their personal journeys and their deepest desires for goodness.

And so it was that I encountered two very different men with very similar stories.

One-hundred-year-old Genshitsu Sen is a remarkable human being and a joyful soul. We greeted each other in Kyoto, during my trip to Japan in November, with a hug and an instant connection.

Not only is Sen a former grand master of the Urasenke tea tradition but he is also an active member of the Rotary Club of Kyoto, where he has served as club president. He assisted in the charter of the Rotary Club of Kyoto-South. And he has also served as governor of District 2650 and held leadership roles in Rotary International and The Rotary Foundation.

During that same week, I had the great pleasure to record a birthday video for a 100-year-old World War II naval hero who is an exemplary leader and who served two terms as governor of District 5810 in Texas.

Both men are decorated World War II heroes in their respective countries and share unthinkable history. And although they served on opposing sides of the war, their stories are remarkably similar — and they are both honorable men who chose Rotary to carry on lives of peacemaking.

Do we work to live or do we live to work?

Here is the question, a dilemma that comes up relentlessly every time and we cannot often give an answer.

Today I will share some of my thoughts on this matter with you dear President Kyriakos, dear friends, ladies and gentlemen Rotarians.

What exactly is the balance between work and personal life? This magic balance is essential for the quality of our lives. Our two lives complement each other.

If one of the two is not working properly, it inevitably affects the other. We strive to catch up on everything and be perfect at everything, thus letting time fly by. In the past there were clear boundaries between work and home. Nowadays, however, work is more likely to interfere with personal life and it is then when balance becomes not such a simple matter.

However this balance is not unattainable.

A study concluded that 50% of workers work more than 8 hours a day.

The constant pressure to work hard and adopt this busy lifestyle leads to intense stress. We know that we need a break. About 46% of workers states that the demands of work often interfere with their personal and family relationships. With family and personal time being limited, stress is caused. Stress itself is an integral part of life.

We certainly live in an era of great professional instability and insecurity, where the demands on most professions are high. Especially in recent years, where the status of labor relations has changed drastically with the establishment of hours and intense competitiveness.

Otherwise, as a result, there will be dissatisfied employees and partners. Because there is guilt when we consider that the time we spend at work has left behind our personal life and vice versa.

So what should we do?

We practice self-reflection?

1. Fatigue. If we are tired, we are not productive.
2. Poor health. Stress is associated with negative effects on the immune system and can cause the symptoms of any medical condition to deteriorate
3. We lose time from our friends and loved ones and wake up one day to find that years have passed

4. Increased expectations. If we regularly work overtime, we take on more responsibilities, which leads to additional worries and challenges. A day has a specific number of hours and that doesn't change. If limits are not set then work and other obligations will absorb all of our time and energy and we won't have time to follow our favorite activities and take care of our relationships.

That's why we should:

1. Manage our time. We don't engage in activities that we don't enjoy and can't manage.
2. We learn to say no. Whenever a colleague systematically asks us to undertake on extra work. When we don't undertake responsibilities from a false sense of obligation or guilt, then we have more time to deal with our own activities.
3. We leave the work in the workplace.
4. We leave emails for a while
5. We listen to our needs
6. We limit our commitments and obligations.

Most people can concentrate for about 90 minutes.

8. We take vacations.
9. Communication is the key word. We request for time and understanding. True communication and good intentions will be appreciated.

Don't forget that there is no perfect balance.

What do we teach our children to do?

To pick a job they like and then they will never have to work. If you hate what you do, you will not be happy.

Of course, our work may or may not satisfy our other needs related to the good life, such as the need for security, for independence, for freedom of initiative, for social recognition, for self-esteem and self-respect, for free time, for peace of mind and calmness, to create and meet challenge, to achieve results, for continuous learning and development, for power, for influencing others, for social contribution and altruism, for contact with other people, etc.

Without work life rots. But when work is lifeless, life degenerates. Recognize yourself the right to be imperfect, there is no such thing as a perfect person. We must accept our defects and weaknesses and our mistakes in fulfilling our duties. What is certain is that if we are not in harmony with ourselves, it is difficult to have a balanced life.

We should not strive for the big plan, we should strive for the realistic one. Balance is achieved over time, not within a day. It is important to be flexible and constantly evaluate our goals and priorities. To remain open to reorientation and the assessment of our needs any day and hour within time, is key to finding our mental and professional balance, i.e. the balance in our life.
