

Presidential Message

At the 2023 Rotary International Convention in Melbourne, I asked all Rotary members to become champions in our effort to illuminate mental health needs near and far. This includes helping one another feel more supported, advocating for mental health services, and building bridges with experts in the field to expand access to treatment.

It's an important task and a big ask. But it's also something that should feel familiar to every Rotary member — because everything we do is in the spirit of caring, giving, friendship, and compassion, and has been from the beginning of our organization.

We've grown into an amazing global network of 1.4 million interconnected community leaders — leaders who share a deep commitment to doing good in the world. But what makes Rotary powerful isn't just what we do for the communities we

serve. We also support and empower each other, by creating a safe space for our members to bring their whole, authentic selves. We show each other comfort and care.

These connections are deeply meaningful. The U.S. surgeon general recently declared lone-liness a public health epidemic. Dr. Vivek Murthy said, "We must prioritize building social connection the same way we have prioritized other critical public health issues such as tobacco, obesity, and substance use disorders." I am proud of what Rotary has done across generations to build those kinds of social connections — and this magazine focused on lone-liness and what Rotary can do about it in its January 2023 issue.

Our worldwide community and our foundational value prioritizing Service Above Self makes Rotary a powerful global advocate for mental health. A recently published study by Ohio State University found performing acts of kindness was the only one of three mental health interventions tested that helped people feel more connected to others. Study co-author David Cregg said, "Performing acts of kindness seems to be one of the best ways to promote those connections."

This research suggests what we've known all along — that doing good helps transform not just the communities we serve, but it also transforms us. As we put a greater focus on mental health, let's not think of this effort as something new to Rotary, but rather as something we can do better and as a result have a greater impact on ourselves and the people we serve.

We are not starting this effort from scratch. The Rotary Action Group on Mental Health Initiatives has been focused on these kinds of issues for several years — and we will be looking to members of that group for leadership as we continue to build awareness.

Mental health care fits comfortably within several of our areas of focus. As of May, there are 41 global grant-supported projects with a mental health focus. Many of them have tremendous promise, and we will be highlighting them in the months ahead.

So let's work together to erase the stigma associated with emotional well-being, raise awareness of mental health needs, and improve access to preventive and interventional mental health services.



Another important development this month is that our website www.rotary.org continues to inform us with its new face and to be our face opening to the world. As you know,



Rotary did not forget the German Shepherd Dog Proteo, who was a member of the Mexican search and rescue team, who lost his life for the people of Adıyaman in the earthquake.

Rotary International Rotary 2420. Regional Federation on behalf of Proteo, the heroic rescue dog who worked with the search and rescue team that came to Adıyaman from Mexico to save the earthquake victim who lost his life in the great earthquake of the century, which happened on February 6, and who helped rescue 2 Adıyaman residents from under the rubble. The Animal Clinic, which was built using the Disaster Fund, was built and delivered to the Veterinary Directorate of Adıyaman Municipality.

Adiyaman Mayor Dr. Visiting Süleyman Kılınç, Rotary 2420th Regional Federation President Mehmet Altay, Past Governor and International Rotary Foundation Regional Officer Hasan Akbayrak, Nemrut Rotary Club Past President Ferit Binzet and accompanying regional officials, together with Hasvet officials, opened the Proteo Animal Clinic and went to the Veterinary Directorate. They made examinations at the delivered clinic.

Rotary 2420. Regional Federation President Mehmet Altay, who stated that they have been working intensely in Adıyaman and the earthquake provinces since the first day of the earthquake, said, "The earthquake, which we also call the Disaster

of the Century, affected not only people but also animals. We have always stood by our people in Adıyaman on many different issues from education to health. I hope we will get through these difficult days together. Currently, we opened a clinic in Adıyaman, where the Mexican search and rescue team, who helped 2 people survive the earthquake, died in memory of the hero dog Proteo. Hopefully, from now on, this clinic will heal our souls on the street. Like Mexico, we will never forget the name of the heroic search and rescue dog 'Proteo'. And we will commemorate it with beauty," he said.

International Rotary Foundation Regional Officer Hasan Akbayrak said, "On the one hand, we are happy to touch various fields. Of course we served our people. We've been here since day one. We worked in containers, we worked with x-ray machines, we worked in ambulances, and we will do many more. Through this clinic, we once again experience that this world does not belong only to us. We are very, very happy. Because we can touch our animal friends, we are here to show them

that their lives are precious. At the same time, dear Proteo, he gave his life for ours, but his name will live on in other souls. We are about to meet in many more beauties."

Veterinarian Yusuf Işık, who works at Adıyaman Veterinary Directorate, said in his speech, "This area is sufficient for us to provide healthier service to stray animals and we have more projects. Hopefully, we will continue to provide better service to stray animals in healthier conditions. The dog named Proteo, who came to Adıyaman from Mexico after the earthquake, saved our two lives in the wreckage, and detected two of our people. Afterwards, he passed away in Adıyaman due to age. For this reason, we named our clinic Proteo animal clinic to show our gratitude to Proteo. I would like to thank Rotary 2420th District Federation, Adıyaman Nemrut Rotary Club and everyone who contributed to this meaningful project."

MOBILE DENTAL CLINIC SUPPORT FROM ROTARY TO ADIYAMAN

Rotary International District 2440 delivered the Mobile Dental Clinic, which was provided by the Earthquake Fund provided by Rotary International, to Adiyaman Provincial Health Directorate.

In Adiyaman, where the wounds continue to heal after the Kahramanmaraş earthquake on February 6, 2023, Rotary continues its activities with social projects without slowing down. Pointing out that very important projects have been implemented especially in the field of Education and Health, Rotary International District 2440 Governor Ayda Özeren said; We continue to be hope, especially for our brothers from Adiyaman, on this path we started with the slogan of "Be Hope for the World". Since the first day of the earthquake, we have undertaken many projects by using the Rotary Earthquake Fund in Adiyaman and other provinces to share the suffering of our people, to heal their wounds and to meet the social needs of schools, health centers, hospitals and living spaces damaged in the earthquake.

All our Rotary clubs across Turkey used all their energies to help the region. We have saved hundreds of families from housing problems in many container cities. We built schools, distributed tents, and our clothing and food aids always continued. Saying health comes first we built a Mobile Dental Clinic in Adıyaman and today delivered it toour Provincial Health Manager Dr. Erdoğan Öz. In the coming days, we will bring and deliver another Mobile Health Center to Adıyaman with the hope that it will serve our people and distribute healing.

Unfortunately, the amount of ghost nets is beyond our ability to measure. Because in order to remove these nets, our diving team collected them by making separate dives for 4 days. The garbage was transported to the Municipality's recycling facilities.

While all these works were being done, a fun environment was created to make this organization enjoyable. At the same time, in our project, which was instrumental in the development of friend-ships, environmentally sensitive measures were taken, each participant consumed their drinks with their own thermos, there was no plastic consumption, and the garbage of the boat was separated.

All of this organization was filmed by Habitat TV and a special episode was dedicated to this project by the channel in question.

We began implementing our second project, "We overcome obstacles with love," between 01/07/2023 and 30/06/2024. When medical foot care is required for our children and teens with disabilities, it is hoped that it would include orthotics, prosthetic insoles, and foot analysis so that they can live their daily lives more easily.


Due to the pressure on our individuals with disabilities' feet and nails, we can encounter deformed nails, ingrown nails, calluses, cracked heels, and other issues.

Medical care can help to reduce these issues. Our initiative is supported by Acıbadem University, Harran University, Podider (Podology Association), Kalecan Orthopedics, and the Rotary family. This initiative, which is a large service project, aims to serve 50 students.

We intend to begin and expand our disabled population with members of the Autism Association and the Adalya Foundation, both of which are affiliated with the municipality. Podologists in Turkey, including myself, will support this effort.

I am very excited to spend a year working on this service project.

As the 30 August Victory Day, which commemorates the establishment of our Republic, is one of our significant national holidays, we plan to provide bicycle support.

Therefore, we proposed an idea to celebrate the 100th anniversary of our Republic in ROTARY CONTAINER village, Hatay Samandağ, with a similar enthusiasm. Initially, this idea appeared unattainable, but we believe it's achievable. We started

right away and let everyone in our area know. After 2.5 months of hard work, we gathered 120 bicycles, which we distributed on 30th August. The ceremony was very emotional, and many people came to see it. Despite feeling exhausted, the joy on the children's faces made all the fatigue disappear. We not only gave out bikes, but also teamed up with the council to create a play area. We brought along a dental van and checked the children's teeth as well as running heart checks. Families with infants were given pushchairs, baby seats and outfits. To top it off, we held sessions to promote bike riding and ran a poetry competition with scholarships awarded to the top three students. At the end of the day, many people were pleased, and we saw hundreds of delighted children. Our injuries from the earthquake are severe, but we will remain supportive of our community. We express gratitude to everyone who aided us on behalf of the Hatay Samandağ locals.



ABOUT BASHAR ASFOUR:

He got infected with Polio when he was just 10 months old. His prolonged treatment was marked by moments of unbearable pain and suffering and spent his youth in hospitals and medical institutions, battling the results of the severe infection, undergoing multiple surgeries, and being supported by his family throughout: "The removal of pins inserted were truly painful and I remember my tears were flowing continuously, not because of the pain but of the joy of being able to do the last phase in my recovery enabling me to walk even with a limp but with no crutches or using my hand to hold my knee while walking. Vaccination is extremely important and we never should take this mission for granted", according to Bashar Asfour.

For over 35 years, Rotary International has spearheaded the fight against polio, achieving significant progress in reducing cases by over 99.9 percent through its partnership with the Global Polio Eradication Initiative. However, recent findings of poliovirus in London's sewage after nearly four decades underscore the ongoing importance of worldwide polio eradication efforts.

Currently, only two countries, Afghanistan and Pakistan, remain endemic to polio, with wild poliovirus transmission yet to be interrupted. Without sustained eradication endeavors, over 20 million healthy individuals face the risk of paralysis caused by the virus. In line with its commitment, Rotary aims to raise \$50 million annually for the next three years, with every dollar matched by an additional two dollars from the Gates Foundation. This expanded agreement will amount to a total of up to \$450 million to support the Global Polio Eradication Initiative.

The days from 1 to 3 September will be remembered with wonderful concerts, friendships and above all with valuable and beautiful music that came out from under the fingers of young guitarists.











These year 2023, when it is 140 years since the great Vazov wrote "The Soldiers of Shipka" and 146 years of the SHIPKA EPOPE, with the help of friends, we helped 18-year-old Vicky conquer St. Nicholas peak.

The one who responded to the invitation, our Paralympic champion Hristiyan Stoyanov, wished the children to set themselves a daily goal of small peaks that they manage to conquer, and that these peaks become louder and louder. 


36TH DARDANELLES SWIMMING COMPETITION SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED ON 30 AUGUST 2023

Canakkale Rotary Club Dardanelles Swimming Competition, which is con-

sidered the oldest swimming competition in the world in Çanakkale, where the greatest epic of the glorious Turkish history was written, has been bringing international athletes together for 36 years in peace and well-being on the route drawn from Europe to the Asian continent.
