Each year, Rotary awards fully funded fellowships for dedicated leaders from around the world to study at one of our peace centers.

Through academic training, practice, and global networking opportunities, the Rotary Peace Centers program develops the capacity of peace and development professionals to become effective catalysts for peace. The fellowships cover tuition and fees, room and board, round-trip transportation, and internship and field-study expenses.

Since the program began in 2002, the Rotary Peace Centers have trained more than 1,600 fellows who now work in over 140 countries. Many serve as leaders in governments; NGOs; education and research institutions; peacekeeping and law enforcement agencies; and international organizations like the United Nations and the World Bank.

Our fellowships

The Rotary Peace Fellowship is designed for leaders with work experience in peace and development. Our fellows are committed to community and international service and the pursuit of peace. Each year, The Rotary Foundation awards up to 50 fellowships for master's degrees and up to 40 for certificate studies at premier universities.

Presidential Message

The World Health Organization designates 10 October as World Mental Health Day, and with Rotary placing a special focus on mental health this year, I would like to help answer the question posed to me most often when I travel to meet members: How can my club get started?

There are some wonderful examples of Rotary members taking action already. In the Philippines, the Rotary Club of Tiaong-Hiyas held a 12-week health challenge for mothers in the community to promote some baseline health screenings and coaching on a healthier lifestyle.

By the end of the challenge, the mothers had a special bond and decided to form a Rotary Community Corps called Ilaw ng Tahanan ("one who lights up the home") with the goal of involving more mothers in health education and wellness support — and later youth services, teen pregnancy prevention, and help with unhealthy

substance use. Almost a year later, the RCC is preparing to open its own health center where mothers can come for peer-to-peer support.

Another strong example is in Colorado. In the fall of 2021, a small group of stakeholders from the Rotary Club of Highlands Ranch formed the Rotary Clubs of Colorado Endowed Fellowship for Pediatric Mental Health, which enhances the ability of Children's Hospital Colorado to recruit and train pediatric psychiatry providers and allows the hospital network to make additional appointments. This increases access to mental health care for children and decreases provider shortages.

Since then, the project has brought on new supporters and is now fully funded with a \$500,000 endowment. Investment income from this endowment will support a fellow — a psychologist or psychiatrist — at Children's Hospital. A new fellow will be named every one to two years, beginning spring of 2024. Over time this will create a cohort to bolster the mental health workforce, treating kids from all 64 Colorado counties and neighboring states.

There are many more great mental health project stories on Rotary Showcase, and I invite you to share your experiences as you begin your own projects. Also, please reach out to mindhealth@rotary.org with any thoughts or ideas you would like to share about mental health in the Rotary world.


Discovering the human connections that bind us is what we do through our membership every day. It's what Rotary has always been about, and we can build on it by helping each other find peace at home.



Thoughts and observations....

Once you are elected as District Governor Nominee in your district you start to learn more about the internationality of Rotary. Past, present, and future district governors, as well as RI Presidents, Directors, Trustees, and Regional Leaders attend Rotary institutes, which are held every year through September to October in each Zone, Region of Rotary International. Although being a Rotarian is the only restriction to attend the Rotary institutes, mostly incoming

district and senior leaders attend the Rotary institutes to share information, build connections, and exchange ideas about their Districts, Zones and the International Rotary. The institutes usually happen just after the Governors Elect and Governors Nominee Training Seminars (GETS/GNTS) and goes on for approximately for three to four days. The program includes:

An update on The Rotary Foundation and its programs; A report on our polio eradication efforts ; A five-year forecast presented by a director or other Board representative; An open forum where participants can make recommendations to the Board; Local and international speakers sharing information on relevant topics.

This October; I have attended the Zone 21 GETS in Bucharest as well as the Zone 21 Institute. These international meetings gives District Leaders a chance to network, meet their classmates, and reconnect with old friends. Training sessions are opportunities to get inspiration for continuing your service and leadership in your community and district. Motivates you; to learn more....As you listening to other leaders experiences, highlights and inside stories you get a chance to restructure your term. Either in administration or your districts committees, your – what I call the "A Team". Now I feel ready. I had strategies, leadership continuity development is essential as well but learned that we have to be cautious on how we can apply conflict management strategies...

In Bucharest we had the chance to review the Action Plan of Rotary better which encouraged every participant to think about Rotary in a different way then usual. Stuff we reviewed helped me to re organize my priorities and objectives to help achieve the specific goals we wished for our terms.

I have seen how I will motivate club and district leaders by developing specific strategies in our learning events like Presidents-elect training seminar (PETS) and the District training assembly (DTA). Engaging, innovating, and inclusiveness will help us to perform better leadership skills. I have decided to make a special "District Vibrant Club Workshop" to smaller Clubs to motivate the Presidents, the board and committee members, as well as the club members.

district responsibilities we have and operations as well as how we can address issues specific to our district.




A ROTARY CLUB MEMBER'S JOURNEY AROUND EUROPE TO END POLIO

A personal cause united thousands of Rotarians in Europe. The cause is that of Bashar Asfour. He was born in Amman, dedicated Rotarian belonging to RC Tbilisi Ambassador. He planned a tour of 16 countries to support the fundraising for the implementation of the Rotary International's highest external project "End Polio Now" to eradicate poliomyelitis in the world.

At the age of 10 months, Bashar Asfour met the polio virus. For almost 20 years, he was in a hard battle with the disease. His parents did everything they could to save him from the indescribable pain and suffering that the disease causes. Bashar run through a series of operations. He spent his youth years in hospitals, recovery facilities and institutions. Thanks to the efforts of doctors and the achievements of medicine, Bashar is currently happy. He feels good that he can walk, meet fellows and enjoy life.

He has erased the scars that the disease has left on him. He won the battle with the disease because of his strong believe he will recover to live.

Few of us would dare to start a long journey like this. Bashar Asfour decided to face a challenge, which he calls "My Journey to End Polio". He strongly believes that more children around the world will receive their vaccines against polio.



In early September, Bashar Asfour set off in his specially branded car from Germany. In less than 65 days, he covered nearly 12,346 kilometers. He crossed Germany, the Netherlands, Belgium, Switzerland, Italy, Greece, Turkey, Bulgaria, Romania, Serbia, Hungary, Croatia, Slovenia, Austria, and the Czech Republic.

No doubt, this is an exhausting journey. Still, the pictures from different parts of Europe, demonstrate the smiles of Bashar Asfour and dozens of Rotarians. Time flies and the hours are marked by numerous friendly and cordial meetings with representatives from 30 Districts on the continent. Every kilometer passed, every visit to the Rotary clubs along the way, brought Bashar Asfour closer to achieving his main goal, to attract \$250,000 in donations for the Rotary International's "End Polio Now" program.

Update: Bashar Asfour should be proud - he has almost achieved his goal, with nearly \$245,000 already raised.

For us, the Rotarians, this is not just a number or a bill, but a sign that hundreds of children around the world will have access to polio vaccines.

Bashar's appeal for donations to Rotary International to implement the "End Polio Now" program has touched many Rotarians.

A ROTARY CLUB MEMBER'S JOURNEY AROUND EUROPE TO END POLIO

For almost 40 years, Rotary International has been fighting polio, making progress in reducing cases by over 99.9% through its partnership with the Global Polio Eradication Initiative. However, recent data on the presence of polio virus in London sewage after nearly four decades, underline the ongoing importance of efforts to eradicate the disease. Currently, only two countries, Afghanistan and Pakistan, remain endemic. In line with its commitment to the "End Polio Now" program, Rotary aims to raise 50 million dollars annually for the next three years.

In a global perspective, Rotary members have donated over \$2.1 billion and volunteer hours to protect nearly 3 billion children in 122 countries from the paralyzing disease.

Bashar Asfour's journey ended before October 24, World Polio Day. However, the website through which each of us can make a donation to the cause will continue to operate for another 2 months, and the goal of Rotary International and, in particular, Bashar Asfour to eradicate poliomyelitis in the world will remain the number one goal for the entire Rotary community, until the disease is completely eliminated.

Let's tell you more about that Special Rotary club! The fight against polio is Rotary's largest project and Rotary Club Ebingen- Zollernalb supports this goal sustainably and efficiently.



"We must not stop drawing attention to this situation right now, as we reach the home stretch! Every support gives children in Afghanistan and Pakistan a chance for happiness and health," says polio coordinator Hans Pfarr.

The Rotary Club Ebingen-Zollernalb launched a strong and unusual campaign in 2019: on the initiative of the former mayor of Albstadt, Hans Pfarr, POLIO stamps were brought onto the market. An idea that is paying off, especially due to Hans Pfarr's enormous, long-term commitment: a total of 56,000 pieces have been sold since 2019.

On August 28, 2023, the acting club president Britta Bienstein handed over a donation check worth €17,000 to the governor of District 1830, Hans-Hinrich Kruse. With the help of this sum of €17,000 from the POLIO stamp campaign, 51,000 children in Pakistan and Afghanistan can be vaccinated thanks to the increase by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.

The stamps worth €0.85 or €1.60 can be purchased in full sheets at www.poliobriefmarke.de. The donation value per sheet is €9.

On 12th September Bashar Asfour, on his way from Stuttgart to Zurich, he stopped at the Rotary Club (RC) Singen on August-Ruf-Straße. He was in his eye-catching VW ID.Buzz, drawing attention to the fact that polio vaccination for children is still urgently needed, stopped in Singen. Welcomed by the President of RC Singen (Hohentwiel), Wilfried Trah, and the polio chair for District 1930, Wilfried Jud, he explained to Rotarian friends and interested citizens in the pedestrian zone why it is still necessary to keep the vaccination rate high.

Even though polio appears to have been almost eradicated, apart from isolated outbreaks of polio in Pakistan and Afghanistan, the vaccination rate must continue to be kept high, as Bashar Asfour explains. By the way, with a donation of 21,000 euros in 2022 for the polio campaign, the RC Singen is in the top of the donor list of German clubs.
