
November is Rotary Foundation Month

For the 11th consecutive year, The Rotary Foundation has received the highest rating — four stars — from Charity Navigator, an independent evaluator of charities in the U.S.

The Foundation earned the recognition for demonstrating both strong financial health and commitment to accountability and transparency.

"We are extremely honored to be recognized," says Foundation Trustee Chair Ron Burton. "It represents the hard work and dedication of countless Rotarians throughout the world. They know their gifts will be used for the purpose for which they were given and that they will, indeed, make a real difference."

The rating reflects Charity Navigator's assessment of how the Foundation uses donations, sustains its programs and services, and practices good governance and openness.



Presidential Message

Next year, Rotary takes a step toward supporting peacebuilding in the Middle East and North Africa region when recruitment begins for our newest peace center in partnership with Bahçeşehir University (BAU) in Istanbul.

A series of events in the coming year will recognize the new center at BAU and Rotary's work to promote peace. The 2024 Rotary International Convention in May will mark 25 years since the first Rotary Peace Centers were announced—coincidentally at the Rotary Convention in Singapore in 1999. Recruitment for the first cohort of Rotary Peace Fellows at BAU also starts in 2024, and selected candidates will begin their program in early 2025.

Since its beginning, the peace centers program has prepared more than 1,700 peace fellows working in more than 140 countries to create a more peaceful world. That is certainly worth

celebrating, but Rotary Peace Fellows are more than statistics on a page. Their actions have helped Create Hope in the World and will continue to do so.

For example, Jennifer Montgomery and Gorett Komurembe — peace fellows from the program at Makerere University in Uganda — are co-founders of Magenta Girls Initiative. The international nongovernmental organization equips Ugandan girls and young women with the support and tools to overcome harmful gender norms, generational poverty, gender-based violence, trafficking, and trauma.

Ndzi Divine Njamsi, another peace fellow who studied at Makerere, has taken lessons learned about Positive Peace and is sharing them with students of his own in Cameroon. He became interested in the Rotary Positive Peace Activator training program after witnessing extremism, online hate speech, and violence in Cameroon. Since completing the program, he has brought his lessons on peace to students at the Yaoundé International Business School and other organizations in the Central Africa country.

The world needs more people like the graduates of the program at Makerere and our other peace fellows. To that end, we can all advance peace by encouraging our local peacebuilders to learn more about Rotary and apply for this impactful fellowship. Rotary members can also mentor candidates for the fellowship. Or you can work with peace fellows who have already graduated. They probably have an initiative or two that would benefit from your help.

Our peace centers in North America, Europe, Africa, Australia, and Asia depend on financial support as well. The program at BAU was made possible thanks to a generous gift of \$15.5 million to The Rotary Foundation from the Otto and Fran Walter Foundation.

This new Rotary Peace Center will offer a one-year professional development certificate in peace and development studies for fellows focusing on peacebuilding within the Middle East and North Africa region.

Peace must be waged persistently; it is the soil where hope takes root. But as with any journey, we take one step at a time. Let's take those steps together.



My Body My Privacy

Rotary Club of Izmir Cakabey, Rotaract Club of Agora, and Rotaract Club of Guzelvali and UCIM (Struggling Against Child Abuse Assosiation), have initiated the "My Body, My Privacy" project with the aim of raising awareness about child abuse. In the first phase of our project, we welcomed UCIM Representatives in to one of our weekly meetings. When we decided to move forward together, in collaboration with Rotary and Rotaract Academy, we organized and held two comprehensive and certified informative training sessions.

First one of these sessions was about the legal and psychological dimensions of child abuse in our community whereas the second one was about cyberbullying.

We also actively followed and supported UCIM's cases during this process. Our next steps are outlined as follows:

- -Providing training to raise awareness of parents and teachers at the community schools we have selected in our region and named as "Community Union Schools"
- -Organizing an informative theatrical play for children.
- -Hosting a comprehensive seminar, which will serve as the final event of the project, with the participation of all the team members included in this project.

Smart Villages

Clean and safe water, renewable energy and sustainable food are essential for human well-being. But almost 800 million people in the World is unable to access to clean water. People, most of the time, walk barefoot to get water from distant, often contaminated, sources. Usually, women and children take this dangerous journey. Attack of wild animals, rival tribes, rapes, miscarriages of pregnant women are very commonly reported during these hikes. Children wastes their valuable school times to be able to obtain a small cup of water. Lack of water gives rise to many epidemic illnesses among poor people. Families cannot farm and produce sufficient food due to absence of water. Therefore; cycle of poverty and hunger goes on and on. Contaminated water takes many more lives then, every war on earth.

In the light of above facts; Cankaya Rotary Club of D2430, has initiated a \$154.160 worth Global Grant Project "Smart Villages" together with D9214. A clean and safe water and reliable solar electric power supply project in 5 villages of Uganda. With this project, approximately 3500 people shall access to clean and safe water. They could manage irrigated farm and produce sufficient food for their families as well. By the help of easily accessible water; hygiene needs of people, especially children will be fulfilled, which will yield to immediate

recovery of illnesses such as diphtheria, dysentery, scabies etc. In short, water will transform lives. In this scope, with the help of fellow Rotarians of Uganda geological surveys are completed, water wells are bored and pipe systems are under construction. Upon completion of the project soon, fountains in neighbourhoods, schools and gardens will supply clean water to inhabitants. Neighbourhoods, in addition, will be furnished with solar panels to supply electrical energy. Saplings and seeds will be provided to villagers to encourage them to farm and produce safe crops using clean water. Attached are before and after views of water sources.



Pedaling for Empowerment

Sümeyye Şahin, who resides in the Netherlands and is not a Rotarian or Rotaractor, set off on 2 September 2023 to travel by bicycle from Enschede to Hatay province in order to raise awareness for the 6th of February 2023 earthquake.

This project was realised under the leadership of the Rotary Club of Hilversum-West and the Rotary Club of Kuşadası and with the participation of many other Rotary and Rotaract clubs, in partnership with the Hatay Metropolitan Municipality.

There are 3 main ideas that the project aims to address, the first of which is to raise awareness of the situation of women engaged in agriculture in Hatay province, which is an earthquake zone. With the income and donations obtained from the project, it is aimed to meet the needs of suitable agricultural land, seeds, grains and many other needs for our women engaged in agriculture in Hatay province through Hatay Metropolitan Municipality.

The second aspect is awareness of carbon footprint. The realisation of the project through bicycles aims to encourage people to use harmless vehicles such as bicycles instead of environmentally harmful morotised

vehicles and to raise awareness about the reduction of carbon footprint.

The third and final idea is that projects do not have to be realised by a Rotary, Rotaract or Interact Club member. Sümeyye set out on this path without any affiliation with any Rotary club and realised a project in which many Rotary and Rotaract clubs were partners. This clearly shows that it is not at all necessary to be a club member to realise projects with Rotary clubs.


Fulfilling a commitment promised during the previous Rotarian Year, RC Thessaloniki-East, joined through a \$1050 donation

as an International Partner to the recently approved Global Grant #2349839, titled "AIC Childcare Centre Kajiado Wash Project". The project, falling under the Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene Rotary area of focus, is led by RC of Nairobi Thika Road, RID9212, Kenya and aims to provide a permanent water source to ensure access to clean and quality water to the AIC Kajiado Child Care Centre, a Charitable Children's Institution in the Republic of Kenya that is dedicated to the full rehabilitation, empowerment and education of physically disabled children. Additionally, it will also support the supply of water to three nearby schools with approximately 3130 students, and approximately 150 households from surrounding community members. In all, more than 4300 persons are expected to be directly benefited by the project. For the community to start benefitting from an already drilled borehole in the area, the project (with a total budget of around \$51500) will finance the construction and operation of an efficient and sustainable water pumping and storage system, with most of its subsystems running on solar energy. A schematic diagram of the system to be built is shown in the following figure.

All members of RC Thessaloniki-East are excited and proud to support this very significant Global Grant project, which is in full accordance to the 2023-2024 Rotary Theme "Create Hope in the World" and we wholeheartedly wish our Rotarian friends of RC of Nairobi Thika Road the best success in its implementation!



Nowadays, is a point is not answering the signal/information simply skip this point to find the proper route. We should and we HAVE adapted to work in this new manner. BTW it is not too much new. The Information and social signal act as fluids.

Here are some challenges we meet. They have been recognized in a brief quiz with fellows from different zone teams.

- TIME the greatest challenge of our era. To be effective we devote our time. Sometimes it is exhausting. Sometimes new and new requirements eat our time.
- Communication with DG and DCommChairs. To establish reliable and productive communication we need at least two-direction. It is too often that the District leaders accept the zone team as competitors. We are not! Remember the main verbs in our role as listed above.
- Adding events after the District Calender is ready or after the end of Rotary year. Expands the time we personally plan and make the communication difficult.
- Downgrading our expertise. Adopt our expertise -> overqualifies team. Adopt expertise. Very often, our teams are overqualified for the daily needs of clubs and districts. It is difficult but we try to be patient even when the qualification of the person on the other end is far away from what has been expected.
- English is a problem. The Coordinator teams have a member from each District. The team members do speak English and the native language. (we are not discussion the multinational districts). The problem for EmpG, Endopolio, Big gifts, etc. It is hard to communicate when the other side does not speak English. At the same time, some matters require deep knowledge in English.
- Same problem is to be dedicated a task and you should contact the DChairs.
- Large Number of clubs in a district, especially joining the RAC to the number of clubs we are expected to contact the DG and DChairs. Still the manuals requires from us to contact club leaders.



- Skipping either internal or external audience. Both are essential and non-dividable parts of the Organisation Body and the Public image target. Both are important!
- Skipping either the highest internal priority the membership, or the highest "external" task – the Polio Eradation. Both are important.
- About donations. They depend on the culture of giving. The best possible is to be able to attract external donors. Still internal are the problem in the zone.

We Search for Solutions

- From time to time it is easier to do an Inter-Team exchange. For example – Maria to contact "my district" and I to contact hers. None is God at home.
- Ask/recommend the District to include the (Zone / Region) in the District communication plan. Quite many Rotarians are not aware of the Zone role. Even I was not aware while being Executive secretary for 3 years, Rotarian information District Chair and District Public image chair about the existence of Zone team.
- Promote Rotarian Mobility as described in p.9 of the manual. We are speaking about some avant-garde approaches to membership increase and sustainability and do not use the simplest proven way – promote mobility.




